Barry Steichen moved for adjournment. The motion was seconded by Kayse Shrum and carried. The recorded vote was:

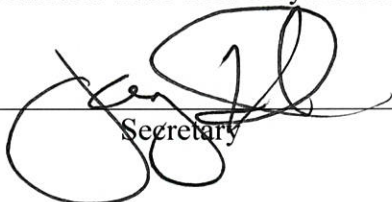
