Ways to get an IRS Tax Return Transcript:

- Request Transcript by Mail - Go to [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov), under “Get a Tax Transcript”, select “Request by Mail”. Make sure to request your IRS Tax Return Transcript and NOT the Account Transcript.
- Request Transcript Online - Go to [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov), under “Get Your Tax Record”, select “Request Online”, Make sure to request your Tax Return Transcript and NOT the Account Transcript.
- Automated Telephone Request 1-800-908-9946. Request your Tax Return Transcript.
- Paper Request Form - Go to [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov). Enter 4506T in search box. Print the form, fill out completely, and submit directly to the IRS (requested transcript will be mailed to the filing address of record with the IRS)

- Each parent is required to submit a letter of nontax filing status from the IRS (dependent students are not required to submit proof of nonfiling). You can obtain this letter by submitting IRS form 4506T (Check Box 7) to the IRS. Form 4506T can be found at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov). The IRS will then forward a letter to you and our office will require a copy of that letter along with these completed verification documents.
- Parents can also receive verification of nonfiling by requesting a copy of the tax transcript at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov). If a transcript is not found, a statement saying you did not file taxes will display on the screen. Print the statement and provide a copy to our office.
- Please provide a copy of your W2(s). If you do not have a copy, you may request your wage and income transcript from [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov)

### Section C. Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose

The student must appear in person at Oklahoma State University College of Osteopathic Medicine Financial Aid department to verify his or her identity by presenting a valid government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport. The institution will maintain a copy of the student's photo ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student's ID.

In addition, the student must sign, in the presence of an OSU Financial Aid representative, the following:
