Example #1:

 policy changes across the county to create changes in healthcare is a future goal she hopes to continue
 after residency.
- Maddie understands that as a future Pediatrician, she will face adversity in her role at times. Her past employment as a daycare worker allowed her to gain experience with children and learn how to interact professionally and respectfully with their families.

Example #2:

- Mark Medical suffered a major athletic injury in college. Through this experience, Mark developed an understanding of the difficult and long recovery process often associated with sports injuries and is hopeful to use this prior experience in his future career in Sports Medicine.
- Mark served as President of Student American Osteopathic Academy of Orthopedics (SAOAO).
 Through networking opportunities within this organization, he discovered orthopedic experiences while traveling abroad with Global Health.
- He was able to maintain a high ranking amongst his classmates in medical school and continues to coach his son in soccer during his free time.

Important Tips:

- ✓ Use proper and professional wording and grammar (i.e., change the word "kids" to "children")
- ✓ Spell out numbers under 10 (zero through nine) or if they appear at the beginning of a sentence
- ✓ Write in 3rd person point of view (do not use personal pronouns like "I", "me" and "my")
- ✓ Don't list every club you belonged to only list leadership positions
- ✓ Do list volunteer awards, if applicable, but not a full listing only highlights
- ✓ Do list missionary work, if applicable, but not a full listing only highlights
