**Return to Title IV Funds**

The OSU Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid, in accordance with federal regulations, calculates the return of Title IV Funds for any student who receives Title IV aid and subsequently withdraws before the end of the enrollment period/term.

**Refunds to Students**

Students will receive their refunds in their bank account within 48 hours after the credit balance occurs on their Bursar accounts if participating in the Direct Deposit Program.

If students do not choose to participate in the Direct Deposit Program, their refunds will be issued by check. Checks are mailed every other Wednesday for credit balances as of the previous Friday. All checks are mailed to the account holder's local address on the SIS system.
