

Terms of Probation Exception Request

Please initial each line and check the appropriate box prior to submitting a request.

The following restrictions apply if you are currently on probation, actively remediating a course, or following the terms of probation after being on probation.

I understand that if I participate in an unapproved activity, a recommendation for a non-cognitive grade will be submitted.

Requests that **may be considered** for approval:

A university-related activity during a period of non-enrollment and not actively remediating a course

Requests that will be **denied**:

Request to run for or hold a leadership position, office in a club or organization, including a committee or an appointment even if that position begins after my probationary period

Request to continue serving in a current leadership or organizational position. (Will only be allowed if an exception is granted by the Dean.)

Request to participate in the Student Ambassador program or in a recruitment event

Request to participate in research, be a Research Assistant, Teaching Assistant, SI leader, or tutor

Request to participate in an externship or internship that is not a requirement for an approved track (Rural, Tribal, or Urban Underserved)

Request to attend a professional meeting exceeding 3 hours.

Request to enroll in an elective that is not a requirement for an approved track (Rural, Tribal, or Urban Underserved)

Request to complete an elective in which I am currently enrolled and not a requirement for an approved track (Rural, Tribal, Urban Underserved)

Request to participate in university related travel that is not required for an approved track (Rural, Tribal, or Urban Underserved)
