OSU BlueCross BlueShield employee health insurance changes:

- The testing of COVID-19 is covered at 100%
- The telehealth visits will have no co-pay until April 30th with an evaluation to extend if necessary
- The treatment for COVID-19 will not have a co-pay, deductible or co-insurance applied to it through May 30th at which time an evaluation to extend will occur; therefore, no out-of-pocket expense to the member receiving treatment
