Dr. Brian Dodge's research focuses broadly on health among sexual and minority individuals, with a focus on not only on health risk behavior but also resilience and wellbeing. He has served as principal investigator on a number of studies examining sexual health among diverse communities of bisexual men and women in collaboration with an interdisciplinary team of academic and community partners, both domestically and internationally. His work has been funded by National Institutes of Health (NIH) and a wide range of other agencies and has been published in American Journal of Public Health, Journal of Sexual Medicine, AIDS Education & Prevention, and Archives of Sexual Behavior (where he serves as Associate Editor).
