Policy Title:Policy and Procedure PolicyPurpose:To describe procedures for policy development for all ACGME accredited programs.Policy Type:Sponsoring Institution Policy

Procedures: Setting of OSUCHS/OMECO Policies

The OSUCHS/OMECO GMEC will review and approve each OSUCHS/OMECO policy every five years for quality assurance purposes. If needed, more frequent review may be required of individual policies or all policies.

Any member of the GMEC, teaching faculty, staff member, resident or fellow may submit suggestions to existing policies to the GME office.

All new policies will be reviewed by GME leadership and then presented to the GMEC for final review and vote.

Policies will be approved by majority vote.

Policies that affect a single residency or fellowship training program that does not affect other programs under OSUCHS/OMECO and does not conflict with any of the sponsoring institution policies, common program requirements, specialty specific program requirements, state or federal law will be identified as a department/program specific policy and does not have to be voted upon by the GMEC.
