

OSU STUDENT, FACULTY & STAFF EXPOSURE PROCEDURE

OUTSIDE TULSA – STUDENT, FACULTY & STAFF EXPOSURE PROCEDURE

- I. Immediately flush, wash, and provide necessary care to exposure site.
- II. Notify your Supervisor and OSU Occupational Health Department at 918-281-2755.
- III. Immediately report the incident to the Rotation Site's Employee Health Department so source labs can be drawn. Forward results to OSU Occupational Health at 918-561-1248.
- IV. Rotation Site Employee Health Department may also draw student/employee's blood for testing. Forward results to OSU Occupational Health Department at 918-561-1248. Any bills can be sent to OSU Occupational Health Department.
- V. Follow-up testing will be conducted at the Rotation Site unless you are assigned to the Tulsa area when the next lab is required.
- VI. If post-exposure prophylaxis is required, treatment will be coordinated by the OSU Occupational Health Department.

TULSA AREA – STUDENT, FACULTY & STAFF EXPOSURE PROCEDURE

- I. Immediately flush, wash, and provide necessary care to exposure site.
- II. Notify your Supervisor and OSU Occupational Health Department at 918-281-2755.
- III. Immediately report exposure to the Rotation Site's Employee Health Department so source labs can be drawn on-site. Forward results to OSU Occupational Health at 918-561-1248.
- IV. Student/Employee should proceed to have blood drawn at an OSU-Saint Francis Lab if exposure occurs during normal business hours. Afterhours exposures will be sent to OSUMC-ER.
- V. All follow-up testing will be coordinated with the OSU Occupational Health Department.
- VI. If post-exposure prophylaxis is required, treatment will be coordinated by the OSU Occupational Health Department.
