

Join ResearchMatch to enhance recruitment in your research!

What is ResearchMatch?

ResearchMatch.org is an online recruitment platform that connects researchers with volunteers who are interested in learning about health-related study opportunities.

How does ResearchMatch work?

Researchers register with ResearchMatch and search the de-identified database for potential participants that match their study's eligibility criteria. If a match is found, researchers can send their contact message with details about the study through ResearchMatch to volunteers.

Joining ResearchMatch as a researcher allows you to view aggregate registry data of volunteers that meet your study's criteria (*feasibility access*).

To gain *recruitment access* to contact volunteers, you need the following:

- IRB approval of ResearchMatch as a recruitment tool
- A health-related IRB-approved study (or exemption)
- An IRB-approved contact message

How will ResearchMatch help me?

ResearchMatch:

- Is a free, low-burden recruitment tool
- Helps streamline your recruitment process
- Connects you with potential study participants
- Allows you to track responses from interested volunteers
